<u>LOCATION</u>
Bedford High School is located at 9 Mudge Way, Bedford, MA. The main entrance to the school has direct access to the auditorium.

NO REGULAR CLASSES WILL BE HELD MARCH 25-28. THERE <u>ARE</u> REGULAR CLASSES 3/29-4/4. There will likely be an altered schedule on Friday 4/5, details TBD.

All recreational students (preschool/Kindergarten, TJB, Hip Hop, Teens, Adaptive, adults, YI) will be scheduled to rehearse in costume on the BHS stage on **Sunday, March 24** (see detailed schedule below). **Please arrive 30** minutes before the on stage time listed, in costume with hair & makeup already done. Mark Lawrence Photography will be set up in a nearby classroom for group and individual pictures.

Sunday, March 24 - Full Costume Rehearsal; any/ all costume changes will be done in the auditorium space, as we don't have access to the dressing rooms during dress rehearsals. One parent/guardian must be present with all children for the duration of rehearsal. Each group will go get a group picture after their dance is done on stage (TJB classes will get their group picture after they finish rehearsing their second dance). You may also order individual pictures at this time.

FULL SHOW RUN THROUGHS: Full dress rehearsals done in the order of each show. One parent/guardian must be present for duration of rehearsal for all preschool and elementary aged children. PLEASE ARRIVE AT 5:15 IN HAIR, MAKEUP, AND COSTUME. Preschoolers and Kindergarteners may leave as soon as they finish on stage. They will be brought back into the audience when they are done. All other students will remain for the duration of the show to rehearse the FINALE. Trophies will be distributed and seniors will be acknowledged at the end of each rehearsal.

COSTUMES

Your child's costume will be distributed during their class observation day in late February or early March. A costume distribution schedule has already been sent out and will be sent again before February vacation week.

TROPHIES

Students who have participated in 5, 10 or 15 recitals are celebrated with a trophy that is given at the Full Show Run Through Rehearsals. **If your child qualifies for this award, please contact the office no later than March 1st to let us know**. Trophies will be ordered on March 2nd. Once the order is placed, we cannot add additional trophies. Graduating seniors are also acknowledged during our trophy ceremony.

RECITAL TICKET INFORMATION

While we are not limiting ticket sales this year, we would like to strongly advise families to be considerate of the studio as a whole when purchasing tickets. This venue has about 530 available seats (larger than the Regent but half the size of LHS) and we want to ensure every family is able to buy tickets to each show their child is in. Please only purchase tickets for friends/ family that have confirmed they will attend and refrain from buying large quantities of tickets (i.e. 10+) with the hope that you can use them all.

All 2024 recital tickets will be ordered online at:

All balances MUST be paid in full prior to ordering recital tickets. You will not receive a code if you have a balance on your account or are not up to date on a payment plan.

All ticket codes will be emailed directly from the ticketing website so be on the lookout for anything from Dance Recital Ticketing or DRT. Priority code emails come from a No-Reply sender. Check junk/spam folders if you don't receive anything on the scheduled dates. They will be mailed to the emails we have on file on your Studio Director account.

- 1. High School seniors will receive an email with a priority code and will have the opportunity to order tickets early on Thursday, February 8th at 9:00am.
- 2. Legacy Dance Company members will receive an email with a priority code on Friday, February 9th and will have the opportunity to order tickets early on Sunday, February 11th at 9:00 am, ONLY IF YOUR BALANCE IS PAID.
- Youth Intensive families will receive an email with a priority code on Friday, February 16th and will have the opportunity to order tickets early on Sunday, February 18th at 9:00 am, ONLY IF YOUR BALANCE IS PAID.
- 4. The remainder of the studio (with a \$0.00 balance) will be emailed a unique code to use to order tickets online on Monday February 26th at 9:00am. Once everyone has paid their bills, codes will no longer be needed and everyone can return to the site and order as many tickets as they like.
- 5. If you have a balance on your account you will not receive a code until your balance is paid or you are up to date with your payment plan. Please email us once you pay so we can send you a code.

- 6. You can order as many tickets as you like online with your personal code but each code can only be used once. New codes may be requested if needed.
- 7. Any family who has their children in different shows will receive a coupon code for 2 free tickets in addition to the priority code. Please be sure to write down the coupon code to be used when you're purchasing tickets.
- 8. Tickets can be printed or downloaded to your device. The Dance Inn will accept a picture on your phone for entrance to the show. You do not need a physical copy if you have your receipt on your phone the day of the event.
- 9. All dancers (including preschool & kindergarten) are backstage for the entirety of the show so they will not need a ticket for the show they are in.
- 10. It is the responsibility of the parents to complete the ticket order. Double-check that you are ordering for the correct show (see image below):

Please note the following policies to avoid a delay in processing your ticket order –

All balances must be paid in full prior to purchasing tickets. Tickets cannot be reserved without full payment. Tickets are \$24 each plus processing fees. Each person admitted to the auditorium needs a ticket, regardless of age. Please do not bring children under 3. Children ages 3 and above need their own ticket to enjoy the show. Performers do not need a ticket and will remain backstage for the entirety of the show.

Massachusetts Fire Laws direct that no one may have another person sitting on their lap in the auditorium.

Tickets will not be refunded or exchanged. **Please complete your order carefully!**

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Parents who volunteer to help out at a recital are eligible to receive a free ticket to any performance throughout the weekend. Volunteer forms (found below) must be filled out and returned to the office before you purchase your tickets so that Ally can send you your special volunteer code.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Will tickets be sold on the day of the show? Yes, if there are still seats available. Online sales will remain open until the beginning of each show or until sold out.

Where is the best place to sit? All the seats provide equal visibility in this auditorium. There is no balcony.

Is there wheelchair seating? Wheelchair accessible seating is available on the left & right side of the auditorium in the back rows. You can reserve a wheelchair spot & an accompanying chair when purchasing tickets online.

I'm going to volunteer at a different recital than the one my child is performing in, how can I redeem the free ticket? Once you have handed in your volunteer form you will receive a one-time use discount code that will allow you one free ticket to any show. You will need to choose a show you are not working. You must turn in your volunteer form before purchasing tickets to receive the coupon!

My children are not in the same show, can I get any free or discounted tickets? For families who have children in multiple shows, they are able to get 2 free tickets to any show. We will send out coupon codes to the families this applies to. This does not apply to children in multiple classes who have each class in a different show.

I don't have the code to purchase tickets but my bill is paid. What do I do? If you do not see an email with your priority code please email the office. We can locate your code and will try to send it again or just tell you what the code is.
